Activities:

Volunteer law students work with Clinic attorneys on Immigration cases.

- Draft correspondence, motions, and other legal documents
- Research
- File court documents
- Accompany attorneys to court
- Appear in court (for 711-law students)

Requirements:

Law students must be **2L or 3L** and have good writing skills. Law students should have a laptop computer and willingness to attend citizen workshops. Spanish-speaking is helpful, but not required.

Time Commitments:

For the 2017 SPRING Term: 12-16 hours per week for 4-8 hours per day.

For the 2017 SUMMER Term: Minimum 4 days per week for 10 or more weeks.
