- Appear in court (Attorneys licensed in Illinois and 711-law students)
- Administrative assignments

Requirements:

Law students must be **2L or 3L** and have good writing skills. Law students should have a laptop computer and willingness to attend citizen workshops.

Spanish-speaking is helpful, but **not** required.
